



PROCES VERBAL OF THE CANVASS OF THE ELECTION RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 16, 2013 ELECTION HELD IN THE SHERWOOD FOREST CRIME PREVENTION AND NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

On Thursday, November 21, 2013, at 6:00 p.m., a quorum of the Board of Commissioners of the Sherwood Forest Crime Prevention and Neighborhood Improvement District ("Board") met at St. Thomas Moore Catholic Church, Rm 3, at 11441 Goodwood Blvd., Baton Rouge, LA 70815 to canvass the election results in accordance with La. R.S. 18:1292.

There having been submitted to the qualified voters the following proposition:

#### **SHERWOOD FOREST CRIME PREVENTION AND NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

Shall the Sherwood Forest Crime Prevention and Neighborhood Improvement District (the "District"), be authorized to request the levy and collection of a parcel fee on each improved and unimproved parcel within the District for a period of ten years, beginning in 2014 and ending in 2023, in the amount of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75) for the first five years which may be increased by an additional \$100 after 2018 all as provided in Act 116 of the 2013 Regular Legislative Session enacting La. R.S. 33:9097.19, with the proceeds of said parcel fee (after deducting the reasonable and necessary costs of collecting said fee) to be used to aid in crime prevention and to add to the security of District residents by providing for an increase in the presence of law enforcement personnel in the District and to serve the needs of the residents of the District by funding beautification and improvements for the overall betterment of the District (an estimated \$228,150 is reasonably expected to be collected from the initial levy)?
